D. Commentary

England

England remains in Step 4 of its roadmap out of lockdown. This means:

- There is no need to stay two metres apart from people you do not live with. There are also no limits on the number of people you can meet.
- In order to minimise risk, the Government recommends that people should limit the close contact with those they do not usually live with, and increase close contact gradually. This includes minimising the number, proximity and duration of social contacts.
- People should meet outdoors where possible and let fresh air into homes or other enclosed spaces.
- The Government is no longer instructing people to work from home if they can, but expects and recommends a gradual return over the summer.
- The requirement to wear face coverings in law has been lifted, but the Government expects and recommends that people wear face coverings in crowded areas such as public transport.



- There are no longer limits on the number of people who can attend weddings, civil partnerships, funerals and other life events (including receptions and celebrations). There is no requirement for table service at life events, or restrictions on singing or dancing. People are asked to follow guidance for weddings and funerals to reduce risk and maintain protection.
- There are no longer restrictions on group sizes for attending communal worship.

The UK Government's key message is that COVID-19 has not gone away and that everybody needs to continue to act carefully and remain cautious.

Scotland

Today, 9th August 2021, all major COVID-19 restrictions have been removed in Scotland, although some protective measures will stay in place such as the use of face coverings indoors and the collection of contact details as part of Test and Protect. Capacity limits of 2000 people indoors and 5000 people outdoors will also remain in place although some exceptions may be possible on a case-by-case basis. These will be reviewed on a three weekly basis to ensure they remain proportionate.

Wales

From Saturday 7th August all of Wales moved to alert level 0. This means:

- legal restrictions on the number of people who can meet indoors, including in private homes, public places or at events, are now removed.
- all businesses and premises can open, including nightclubs.
- people should still work from home wherever possible.
- face coverings will remain a legal requirement indoors, with the exception of hospitality premises. This will be kept under review.
- fully vaccinated adults, under 18s and vaccine trial participants will not need to self-isolate if they are a close contact of someone with coronavirus.

Northern Ireland

UK Vaccines Delivery Plan

Almost 47.8million people across the UK had received the first dose of a COVID-19 vaccine and over 39.2 million had received their second dose, by the end of 6th August 2021.

International travel

The red, amber and green traffic light system for people entering England remains in force and fully vaccinated people returning to England from most, but not all, countries do not need to quarantine. The list is reviewed every three weeks.

From 8th August 2021, arrivals from France who are fully vaccinated with a vaccine authorised and administered in the UK, US or Europe do not need to quarantine.




Dates of interest

Monday 16th August 2021:

Self-isolation will be removed for fully vaccinated adults in England, meaning that if an individual is fully vaccinated or under 18, they will not be required to self-isolate following close contact with someone who has COVID-19. They will be required to take a PCR test and self-isolate if the test is positive, or you have symptoms.

In England, regulations require that from 11 November 2021, anyone working or volunteering in a care home will need to be fully vaccinated against COVID-19, unless exempt.
